GLOUCESTER COUNTY INSURANCE COMMISSION RESOLUTION OF AUTHORITY FOR SETTLEMENT WITH PETITIONER, HEATHER HILLS

WHEREAS, Heather Hills (hereinafter "Petitioner"), alleged that on January 18, 2011, the employee states while loading a patient into an ambulance, she slipped on the slush and ice and twisted her knee; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner alleged that on February 20, 2014 the employee states she was walking backwards carrying a patient and tripped over a large black duffle bag on the floor; and

WHEREAS, the incident subsequently resulted in the filing of two workers' compensation claims styled as <u>Heather Hills v. Gloucester County</u> in the Workers' Compensation Court, Claim Petitions 2012-22169 and 2014-10595 (the "action"); and

WHEREAS, an Order for Dismissal for Lack of Prosecution was entered on July 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned claim and action so filed have now been dismissed, and;

WHEREAS, there is a \$60.00 stenographic fee payable by Respondent to Guy J. Renzi & Associates.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Gloucester County Insurance Commission that payment of the \$60.00 stenographic fee payable to Guy J. Renzi & Associates is authorized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proper Commission officials and/or their agents, be and are hereby authorized to execute such documents as shall be necessary to effect the disposition set forth.
