GLOUCESTER COUNTY INSURANCE COMMISSION RESOLUTION OF AUTHORITY FOR SETTLEMENT WITH PETITIONER, CARMEN ZAMPAGLIONE

WHEREAS, Carmen Zampaglione (hereinafter "Petitioner"), sustained a work related injury when Petitioner alleges that he hyperextended his right knee while stepping out of a truck on June 6, 2018 (the "incident"); and

WHEREAS, the incident subsequently resulted in the filing of a workers' compensation claim styled as <u>Carmen Zampaglione v. Gloucester County Utilities Authority</u> in the Workers' Compensation Court, Claim Petition 2018-20922 (the "action"); and

WHEREAS, an Order approving settlement was entered on November 12, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned claim and action so filed have now been resolved, and;

WHEREAS, a SETTLEMENT has been negotiated and agreed upon between Petitioner and the County of Gloucester, totaling \$17,080.88 inclusive of applicable fees and costs for Claim Petition 2018-20922, and;

WHEREAS, the Settlement is not intended, nor should it be intended to be an admission of any liability wrongdoing, or impropriety by the parties, and;

WHEREAS, the Settlement has been evaluated by defense counsel for the Gloucester County Insurance Commission, and;

WHEREAS, the Gloucester County Insurance Commission believes that it is in its' best interests to enter into the Settlement with Petitioner so as to ensure that all matters set forth in and involving the claim and action are forever resolved.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Gloucester County Insurance Commission that disposition of the claim filed by the above-referenced individual is authorized as follows:
